We invite you to the most profitable tour to European cities. Shopping in three countries of Europe - Germany, France and Switzerland - will give you unforgettable pleasure and allow buying designer clothing at the best price.

Day 1. Arrival at the airport of Stuttgart / Zurich. Transfer to the hotel. Free time in the town of Donaueschingen (transfer included).

Day 2. Sightseeing tour to the Black Forest (Germany). Dense coniferous forests, crystal clear lakes, nice small houses just like in a fairy tale – this is the Black Forest, one of the most beautiful places in Germany.

You will go for a walk along the scenic lakeside of Titisee, take pictures of the Germany's largest waterfall and visit the 1000 cuckoo clocks store, which were invented in the Black Forest in the 18th century.

Day 3. Shopping in Metzingen.

You will do fascinating shopping in one of the most famous outlets in Europe - Metzingen. The history of the outlet began almost a century ago, when a small atelier was established in the town. After a few decades this atelier has become the Hugo Boss brand and Metzingen - the world-famous shopping center. Today the Outletcity Metzingen offers such brands as Adidas, Calvin Klein Jeans, Lacoste, Timberland, Nike, Levi's, Reebok, Prada, Armani and others. Every year new well-known brands are represented in the Outletcity.

Day 4. Shopping in Freiburg.

The main shopping street of Freiburg - the Kaiser-Joseph-Strasse – is definitely worth a visit. Many famous trading houses, boutiques of fashion clothing and fashionable sportswear, jewellery shops, cafes and restaurants are located there. A lot of antique shops in the Konviktstrasse, shoe stores and leather goods in the Schusterstrasse are waiting for you as well.

Day 5. Free day. An excursion can be booked in the hotel.

Day 6. Shopping in Strasbourg.

Strasbourg is called the «crossroad of Europe» as many trade routes converge here. Most stores are located in the center on the so called «Big Island». However there are no less shops in the next street called the Löwenstrasse. In the Altstetten district you will find the biggest shopping mall of the city – the «Letzipark».

Day 8. Transfer to the airport of Stuttgart / Zurich.



Day 4. Tour to Strasbourg (France). The Old Town, the Cathedral of Our Lady of Strasbourg. (Optional excursion - 90 euro)

Strasbourg is situated on the border of France and Germany and that's why its architecture and atmosphere retain exceptional Franco-German features. Almost the entire city center is declared as UNESCO World Heritage Site. The true symbol of the city is the Cathedral of Our Lady of Strasbourg. This magnificent temple has the 142 meter high spire and is lovingly called by the Alsatians «the Pink Angel» because of its amazing red-brown sandstone lace.



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Day 5. Excursion to Lucerne (Switzerland). The Kapellbrücke Bridge, the Lion Monument. (Optional excursion - 90 euro)

Lucerne is considered as a magical city, and it's no coincidence. According to the legend its name - «Luminous» - is connected with the angel, who illuminated the path to the place, where the city was founded. Besides, there is one of the oldest European wooden covered bridges in Lucerne - the Kappelbrücke Bridge. And the Lion Monument, the famous rock carving of a dying lion, is the symbol of the city.

Day 6. Sightseeing tour to the Black Forest (Germany).

Dense coniferous forests, crystal clear lakes, nice small houses just like in a fairy tale - this is the Black Forest, one of the most beautiful places in Germany. You will go for a walk along the scenic lakeside of Titisee, take pictures of the Germany's largest waterfall and visit the 1000 cuckoo clocks store, which were invented in the Black Forest in the 18th century.



Day 7. Tour to Constance, visit to the islands of Mainau and Reichenau (Germany).

The historical town of Constance is located on the shores of Lake Constance. There was the episcopal residence for 1200 years, that is why many temples are built here. The most famous of them is the Constance Minster, which reflects architectural traditions of different ages. Also it is worth to visit the Obermarkt square, to see unique house facade murals, the ruins of an ancient fortress and „The Imperia” statue, which is called «Statue of Liberty on the Lake.» Then you can go to one of the islands located near Constance: to the «Island of Flowers» Mainau or to the Reichenau monastic island.

Day 3. Trip to Liechtenstein, visit to the Rhine Falls.

The Principality of Liechtenstein is one of the European microstates.

We will visit its capital Vaduz, admire its landmark - the princely castle dating back to the IX century, visit The Postage Stamp Museum, which confirms the reputation of Liechtenstein as one of the best stamps manufacturers in the world, and taste wine in the princely wine cellars. At the entrance to the town of Balzers you will be amazed by the medieval Gutenberg Castle, its impregnable walls, gabled roofs and the stunning view of the Rhine Valley and snow-capped peaks of the Alps. After the tour in Balzers you will make for «the European water miracle» - the famous Rhine Falls. The width of the seething stream is 160 m and the flow falls down from the height of 23 meters.

The Greater Basel and its places of interest are just what we recommend you to visit: the Basel Minster built in the Romanesque - Gothic style, the fascinating Town Hall and the Mittlere Brücke Bridge, that provides majestic scenery. If you are travelling with

children, we would like to recommend you The Toy Museum, where dolls and dollhouses, teddy bears and toy carousels from all over the world are exhibited.

Day 3. Tour to Zurich, trip to the Rhine Falls (Switzerland). (Optional excursion - 90 euro)

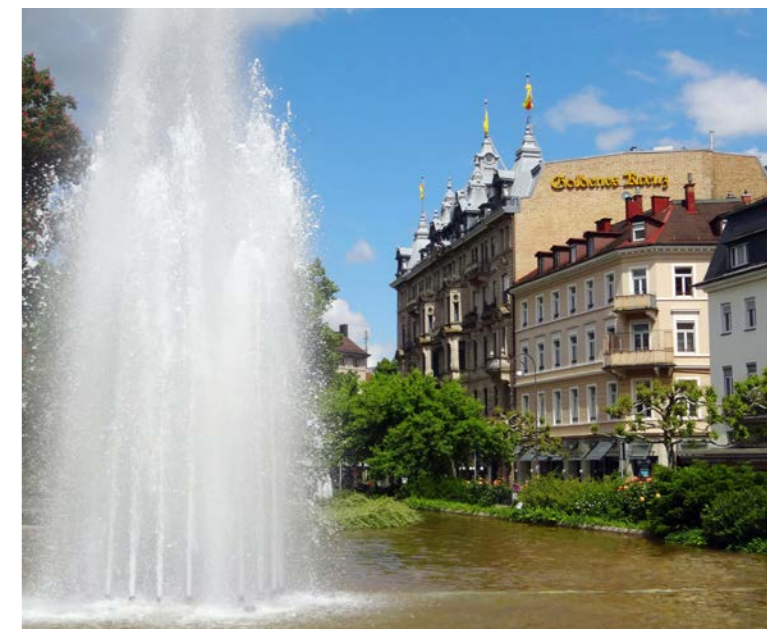

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Castles and cloisters of France and Germany

Day 1. Arrival at the airport of Stuttgart / Zurich. Transfer to the hotel. Free time in the town of Donaueschingen (transfer included).

Day 2. Excursion to the Mont Saint-Odile Abbey and the town of Obernai.

A famous pilgrimage place – a nunnery known as the Mont Saint-Odile Abbey - is situated among the cliffs and rocks of the Vosges Mountains. According to the legend the water from the “holy spring”, located near the nunnery, is curative and returns eyesight. Day 3. Trip to the Haut-Koenigsbourg Castle and the town of Selestat.

You will find fascinating the journey to one of the most beautiful castles of Alsace – Haut-Koenigsbourg. Built of red sandstone the castle stands out against the dark coniferous forests. The castle dates back to the 12th century, but the today's appearance goes back to the year 1908 because of complete renovation. The castle is located 10 km from the town of Selestat, which is considered as the birthplace of the Christmas tree. Fine Renaissance mansions, Gothic and Romanesque churches and medieval towers impart unique charm to the small town.

Day 4. Tour to the Hohenzollern Castle and the university town of Tübingen.

You will visit the ancestral lands of the Hohenzollern dynasty – the fabulous «Castle in the Sky.» This poetic name is connected with the



castle location on the top of a mountain, which is often covered by clouds and mist and the castle seems to soar in the air. During the second part of our tour we will visit the capital of Swabia – Tübingen, see medieval timber framed houses, admire the beautiful embankment of the Neckar River and learn, why Tübingen is considered as classic university town.

It is called «old» in contrast to the «new» baroque palace, which was built in the 18th century for the bishops of Constance. Today the castle possesses an extensive collection of furniture, weapons, objects of everyday use and works of art dating back to the Middle Ages and the Renaissance. Besides, the Dagobert's Tower offers a magnificent view of Meersburg, Lake Constance and the Alps.

Day 7. Excursion to the Beuron Archabbey and the Sigmaringen Castle.

In the Beuron monastery we will visit the pilgrimage church of St. Martin and admire its sumptuously painted ceiling and altar created by the German sculptor Joseph Anton Feuchtmayer. The side chapel with a big round dome is painted in the Beuron art school style. And on the steep bank of the Danube River we will find the majestic castle Sigmaringen in all its splendor. We will go through the halls of the palace, marvel at the magnificent tapestries and visit the armoury, which contains the largest European private collection of armor and weapons.

Day 8. Transfer to the airport of Stuttgart / Zurich.



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Absolutely different Germany

Are you used to the fact, that Germany is considered as a country of beer festivals and commercial exhibitions? Look at this part of Europe from the other side! During a fascinating journey through the Baden-Württemberg region you will visit the sunniest place in Germany, a famous spa complex and one of the oldest cities in Europe!

Day 1. Arrival at the airport of Stuttgart / Zurich. Transfer to the hotel. Free time in the town of Donaueschingen (transfer included).

The main attraction in Donaueschingen is the mysterious Prince's Palace with its beautiful park. Besides there are many other places of interest: the source of one of the largest European rivers - the Danube, the Biedermann Museum known for its unique mirror hall and a beautiful old cathedral.

Day 2. The city of Stuttgart. In the splendour of the Kings. The Romanov and Württemberg dynasties in Europe.

Stuttgart, the capital of the Baden-Württemberg state, is a city, which connected the Russian Romanov imperial dynasty with the Kingdom of Württemberg through the marriage of princesses

Dorothea and Charlotte to the Russian Tsar Paul I and the Duke Michael. Stuttgart welcomed the Russian grand duchesses Olga, Catherine and Vera Romanov as well, who married the Württemberg monarchs.

We will take a stroll through the historic city center in the shade of sycamore alley, visit the Collegiate Church, where more than 90 dukes of Württemberg are buried, go up to the observation tower and admire the view of magnificent vineyards and the picturesque town.

Day 3. The»Russian« city of Baden-Baden, from Gogol to Tolstoy. Optional excursion - 90 euro.

You will travel to the most famous resort in Germany - Baden-Baden. Since the 19th century this town was the favourite place of resort for Russian princes. Famous writers and poets such as Gogol, Turgenev, Zhukovsky, Dostoevsky and



Tolstoy came here to improve their health. Walking through the quiet streets and alleys of Baden-Baden you will see the famous baths, admire the architecture of the spa resort and casino complex Kurhaus built in the neoclassical style and visit one of the oldest gambling establishments in Europe, which was described by Marlene Dietrich as «the most beautiful casino in the world.»

Day 4. Freiburg – the city of legends.

The university town Freiburg, located on the crossing of three countries (Germany, France and Switzerland) welcomes its guests with the song of brooks running through the main streets for a thousand years. The Old and the New City Halls, The Whale House, the fishermen's and tanners' quarters, plenty of legends and fairy tales – that is what immerse you into the atmosphere of the Middle Ages. The symbol of the city is the Freiburg Minster with its tracery stone spire, intricate gutters, numerous sculptures, magnificent stained-glass windows and the main altar painted by Hans Baldung Grien.

Day 5. The Fabulous Black Forest.

You will make sure that the famous Russian poetess Marina Tsvetaeva was right poetizing the Black Forest. Dense coniferous forests, crystal clear lakes, nice small houses just like in a fairy tale – this is the Black Forest, one of the most beautiful places in Germany. You will go for a walk along the scenic lakeside of Titisee, take pictures of the Germany's largest waterfall and visit the 1000 cuckoo clocks store, which were invented in the Black Forest in the 18th century. Besides there is an opportunity to admire spectacular views from the highest point in the region. (Optional excursion - 90 euro)

Day 6. Tour to Friedrichshafen. The Zepplin Museum and the Dornier Aircraft Museum.

Friedrichshafen is a harbor on Lake Constance. Numerous tourists are walking and wondering at the engine roar of the airships soaring in the sky. Just in this town Count Zeppelin made the first flight of his airship in 1900. The museum visitors have the opportunity to enter the cabin and the saloon of the largest airship and see the power of the Maybach engines. More than 400 displays are waiting for you in another museum – The Dornier Aerospace Museum. You will see the famous Dornier Do 26 – a long-range maritime reconnaissance aircraft and even get into the light attack jet „Alpha Jet“, which Germany and France are armed with.

Day 7. Lake Constance. The island of Lindau - the heir of the Roman Empire.

The history of the most beautiful and the largest resort island on Lake Constance dates back to the Roman Empire. In the old town you can find wonderful medieval German buildings. The harbor is guarded by a six-meter high stone lion and two ancient lighthouses - one of them dates from the 12th century AD. The Lindau Sailing Club is the organizer of the regatta «Around Lake Constance». Besides the German cycling race called "Deutschland Tour" and other international athletics competitions take place in Lindau. We will go for a walk through the ancient streets of the city, visit the oldest church on Lake Constance, where frescoes by Hans Holbein the Elder remain today and find out why the locals believe, that the German famous traditional song «Oh, Du Lieber Augustin» was written in Lindau.

Day 6. Tour to Berne.

The city of Bern is one of the smallest capitals in Europe, whose appearance has not changed for 1,000 years. Historic towers, 11 unique fountains, the most monumental temple in Switzerland - the Bern Minster - that are the

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reasons why UNESCO declared Bern the World Heritage Site. You will take a walk along the longest in Europe shopping promenade, admire the astronomical clock with moving figures and see the symbols of Bern - brown bears living leisurely at the bank of the sky-blue Aare River.

Day 7. Bernese Alps: gorges and waterfalls.

We will follow in the footsteps of the famous detective Sherlock Holmes: go up by the rock railway to the Reichenbach Fall, where the decisive fight with Professor Moriarty took place, and visit the Holmes' study in the museum. After that we will walk through the deep canyon of the Aare River and then go to the Lauterbrunnen waterfalls valley, where a lift, located directly inside the rock, moves the visitors to the Trümmelbach Falls, which gather water from the glaciers of the three famous peaks of Switzerland - Jungfrau, Mönch and Eiger.

Day 2. The Black Forest Regional Park or the indoor adventure park Sensapolis.

The Black Forest Regional Park is distinguished as the largest nature park in Germany. In the valleys and on the slopes, in thickets and on the meadows live foxes, bobcats, deer, roe deer, wild boars and other animals. There are many playgrounds, an alpine slide, a water slide, a small zoo and a comfortable café in the entertainment part of the park. In the cold season you can visit the indoor adventure park Sensapolis instead of the Black Forest Regional Park. Water slides, pirate schooners,

spaceships, a fairy tale castle and interactive displays in the entertainment and educational center are waiting for children and adults!

Day 3. The water park Badeparadies.

In the water park Badeparadies you can get to the relaxing holiday atmosphere like on a tropical island. Palm trees, huge water slides and a wave pool will give your children a lot of fun and joy whereas you can luxuriate in the sauna with healing water saturated with the Dead Sea salt.

Day 4. The Steinwasenpark.

The nature, wildlife and exciting adventures – that is what the Steinwasenpark offers you. The park is situated close to Freiburg in an

unusually picturesque location surrounded with dense forests and artificial lakes. In the vast open-air enclosure you can find more than 30 species of animals. The most intrepid travellers can cross the longest in the world rope bridge and try out summer carting and bob-sleigh tracks.

Day 5. The climbing park Kletterwald, Feldberg or the Zeppelin Museum.

If you like extreme entertainment, ladders, ropes and bungee are waiting for you in Kletterwald. After you overcome all the obstacles of the climbing park, you can admire the magnificent scenery from the highest point of the Black Forest – the Feldberg Mountain. However, if the sky and the history of sky exploration attract you more than beautiful landscapes, you have an opportunity to visit the Zeppelin Museum in Friedrichshafen, where you find unique first aircraft collection.

Day 6. The Europa-Park.
